It is a safety issue when children are unattended in the school hallways, or outside, while the parent(s) is/are in a classroom conference.

During conferences two other things will be going on in the school. In the media center, there will be a Scholastic Book Fair. Stop in and pick up some new books to interest your student(s)! Also, the teachers put in very long days during conference week. On conference days, many teachers are not even able to break away for dinner. We ask that the families help them out by bringing in food for the teachers to snack on and for their dinner.
